The primary responsibility of this role is to drive supply chain strategy and support day-to-day execution of Latin American supply chain and several US product lines within the global supply chain management organization. Individual will partner closely with Latin American region and US region sales, marketing, and finance team and other product supply functions to deliver product launch and promotion launch strategies, develop robust demand plan analyses, net requirements, and production plans, set SKU level inventory targets, and manage inventories to those targets.

The incumbent will:

- Be accountable for forecast accuracy, customer service, inventory levels and supply chain costs;
- Lead Product supply related regional business planning activities, including supply chain strategies, product lifecycle management, and new product launches for all Latin America product lines and 1-2 product lines in US;
- Serve as primary product supply liaison and strategist with regional commercial sales, marketing, and finance organization for all Latin America product lines and 1-2 US product lines;
- Ensure inventory targets reflect supply chain reality and customer service agreements for all Latin American product lines and 1-2 US product lines;
- Support the Latin American countries in the development of a robust demand forecast that is agreed to by sales and marketing, including an analytically driven demand planning process and participate in detailed supply analysis and review meetings;
- Lead unconstrained net requirements planning process for all SKUs in Latin American region and for 1-2 US product lines;
- Ensure promotions, new products and packaging changes are planned for and implemented on-time and within budget;
- Actively participate on cost savings projects at regional suppliers;
- Manage regional supply planning for assigned product lines, including inventory, new product launch planning and production levels;
- Ensure accurate translation of sales forecasts for assigned product lines into production requirements, insuring materials are on hand to support production plans, and maintaining the supply chain infrastructure.

The selected candidate is required to possess the following:

- Bachelors degree in business or technical field and 7+ years in demand and supply planning;
- Extensive understanding of SAP, SAP transactional system and Supply Chain Management, specifically DP and SNP modules
