## **Lehigh Valley Roundtable**

### **2004 Scholarship Program**

The **Lehigh Valley Roundtable** of the **Council of Logistics Management** offers a competitive scholarship program for undergraduate students in the region in and around the Lehigh Valley. The purpose of the program is to further the Council's educational goals and to enhance interest in the logistics profession.

#### **Eligibility:**

The Scholarship program is open to either of the following:

- Any college or university student who resides in Berks, Lehigh, Carbon, Lackawanna, Northampton, Monroe, Luzerne, or Schuylkill Counties, Pennsylvania or Warren or Hunterdon Counties, New Jersey and/or
- Any college or university student who resides elsewhere and attends a college or university in the counties specified above.

#### **Awards:**

Scholarships in the amounts of **\$1,500** and **\$1,000** will be awarded to qualified student, in care of the university, for the 2004-2005 school year. The awards will be presented at the Roundtable's May, 2004 dinner meeting.

Each applicant must demonstrate interest in a logistics career by at least one of the following:

- Pursuing a major, minor, or concentration in logistics or supply chain management
- Successfully pursuing academic courses in logistics or supply chain management
- Holding or having held a logistics or supply chain management-related job or internship.

#### **Entry Requirements:**

1. A completed application (enclosed).
2. A college or university official transcript(s).
3. A letter of recommendation from a member of the faculty.
4. Evidence, if applicable of holding a logistics-related job or internship, including the name and address of the employer, name of a reference in that organization, and a description of your duties and responsibilities
5. A double spaced, typewritten essay, of not less than 300 nor more than 500 words responding to the following:

**How can the logistics profession make a difference in solving one of the pressing problems in the world today?**

You choose the problem. We are interested in the creative and effective ways that you can link concrete logistics disciplines, skills and approaches to making the world a better place.
