

Global Logistics Manager

Presently each of the manufacturing sites are handling their own logistics. It is time for a change. In this role you will be responsible for creating and overseeing all corporate global logistics requirements. Will interact closely with plant operations, supply chain, aftermarket and contract management to determine best mode and lane of product shipment in each location.

In order to be considered for this key role you must have functioned in a similar capacity for at least 10 years. You must also be a licensed customs broker. A BS degree is also required, an advanced degree is preferred. You must also have demonstrated experience in all transportation modes (air, ocean, parcel, LTL, and multi-modal). Position will also involve both domestic and international travel, estimated at 25%. Finally, you must have a detailed understanding of Harmonized Tariff Schedule, international trade agreements and a detailed knowledge of Homeland Security requirements regarding international shipments.

Day-to-day responsibilities will include the following:

- Global negotiation and contract management of all freight based spending.
- Supplier management of all carriers, brokers, forwarders, third party payment providers and publish metrics of performance.
- Lane management and compliance to routing guide for inbound and outbound freight.
- Actively manage and administer duty drawback privileges, both direct and third party
- Teach and train global operations in the field of international logistics.
