JOB DESCRIPTION:

Design, develop, and manage a global supply chain that meets the Business Line’s strategic objectives within a low volume, high mix manufacturing environment. This is a hands-on manager position with no direct reports so this person must have the skills and initiative to achieve their goals. This person will play a critical role in ensuring that INFICON’s supply chain can provide the on-time delivery, cost, and quality that is expected.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Accountable for the development and the training of Strategic Sourcing work standards focused on key areas such as: supplier selection, supplier evaluation and risk assessment, supplier performance scorecards.
- Perform evaluations as required to confirm process control and capabilities, quality systems, capacity needs, and lean manufacturing expectations. Ensure there is a robust corrective action and follow-up process.
- Accountable for managing projects which will deliver annual cost savings, improve vendor on-time delivery and ensure a consistent high quality of materials. Expected to work with suppliers to promote Lean Six Sigma tools and processes in order to achieve and sustain these savings and improvements.
- Track and project related commodity prices and market conditions.
- Participate on new product development teams to facilitate DFM, FMEA, DOE, and FAI requirements.
- Coordinate the involvement of suppliers in the development of new products and standardize the use of early supplier involvement tools.
- Ownership for the inspection parts process and determining the criteria for when parts should be inspected or dock to stock. Work with engineering to determine the inspection process steps.
- Present and implement material savings projects. Organize and lead cross functional teams to implement cost savings projects. Projects to include material handling, scrap or rework reduction, material processing improvements, etc.
