Eligibility & Requirements



Eligibility:

Any undergraduate or graduate student attending a University or College in the State of New York

Or

Any undergraduate or graduate student whose permanent residence is in the State of New York but attends a University or College elsewhere

Requirements:

- Pursuing a major, minor or concentration in logistics, supply chain, or a related field
- Anticipated date of graduation is after September 2009
- Must be a student in good standing or higher (through end of most recent semester)
- Completed Application Form and Essay (see Application Form)
- One letter of Reference
- Original Transcript through end of most recent semester

Each application will be given fair and equal consideration. The recipient will be selected without regard to race, color, sex, religion, or national origin.
- The CSCMP-NYC Scholarship Committee will present its recommendation to the Executive Board for final review and approval after personal interviews with the three selected finalists.
- The President and Education Chair of the CSCMP-NYC Roundtable will inform all applicants of the decisions and award.
- The winner will be notified by May 15, 2009 and the scholarship will be awarded at the September 2009 Roundtable event.
