- Work together with outsourcing partners to set up new logistical solutions (new carrier, new distribution network) that meets customer requirements.

- Reduce transportation cost by improving order pattern, space utilisation, combined shipments, knowledge of shipping procedures, routes and rates.
- Work together with our packaging department to optimize space utilisation.
- Visit key customers to improve logistical solutions and improve partnership. Drive processes and system improvements within area of responsibility. Contact carrier representative to make arrangements and to issue instructions for shipping and delivery of materials.
- Develop proposals that include documentation for estimates
- Manage the logistical aspects of product life cycles including coordination or provisioning of samples and the minimization of obsolescence.
- Analyze data gathered and develop solutions or alternative methods of proceeding.
- Confer and correspond with establishment representatives to rectify problems, such as damages, shortages and nonconformance to specifications.
- Document findings of study and prepare recommendations for implementation of new systems, procedures or organizational changes.
